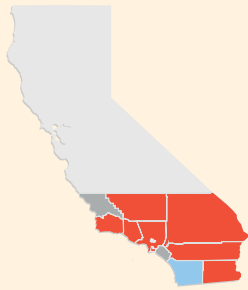
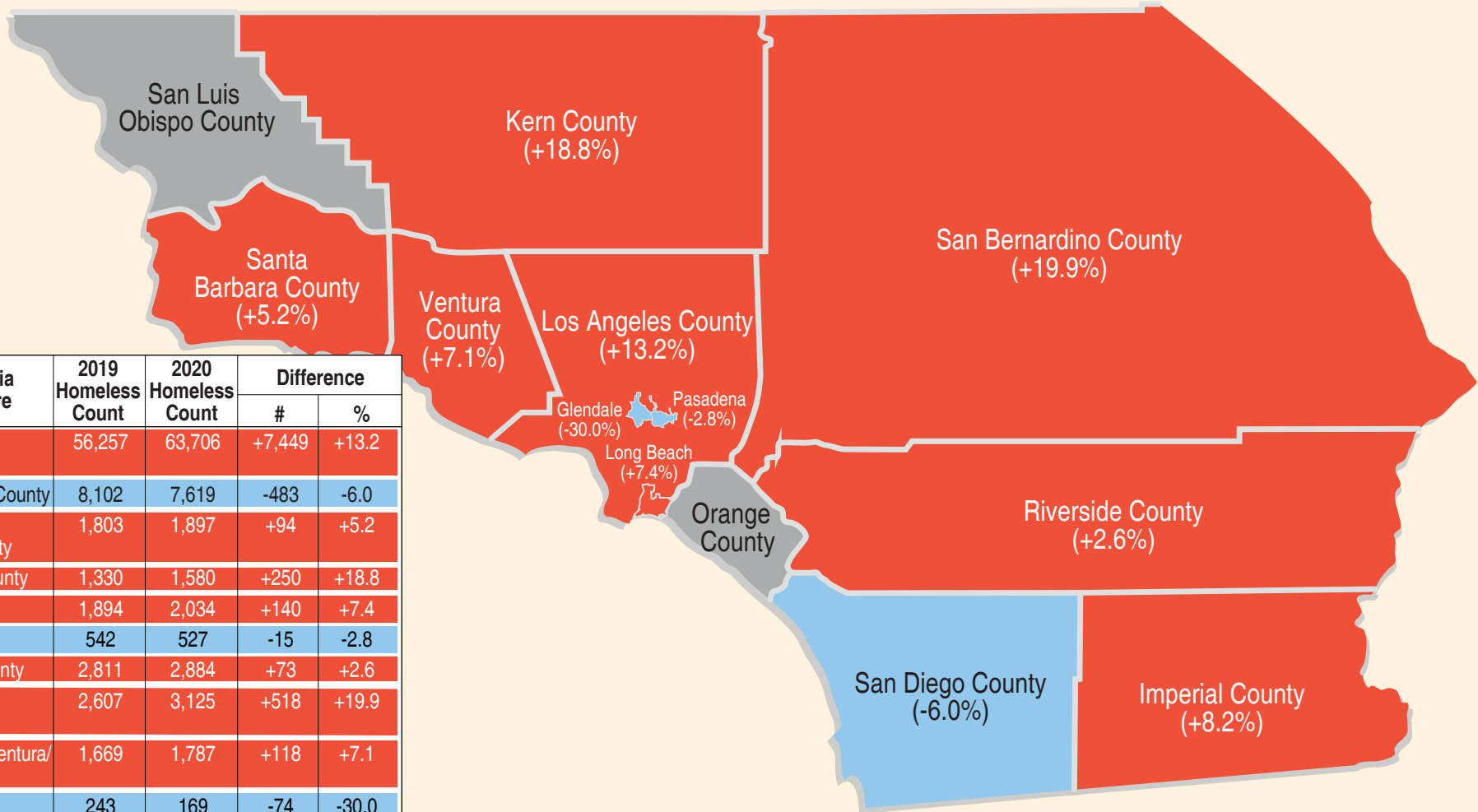


# Southern California Continuums of Care: Comparison of 2019 and 2020 Homeless Counts
